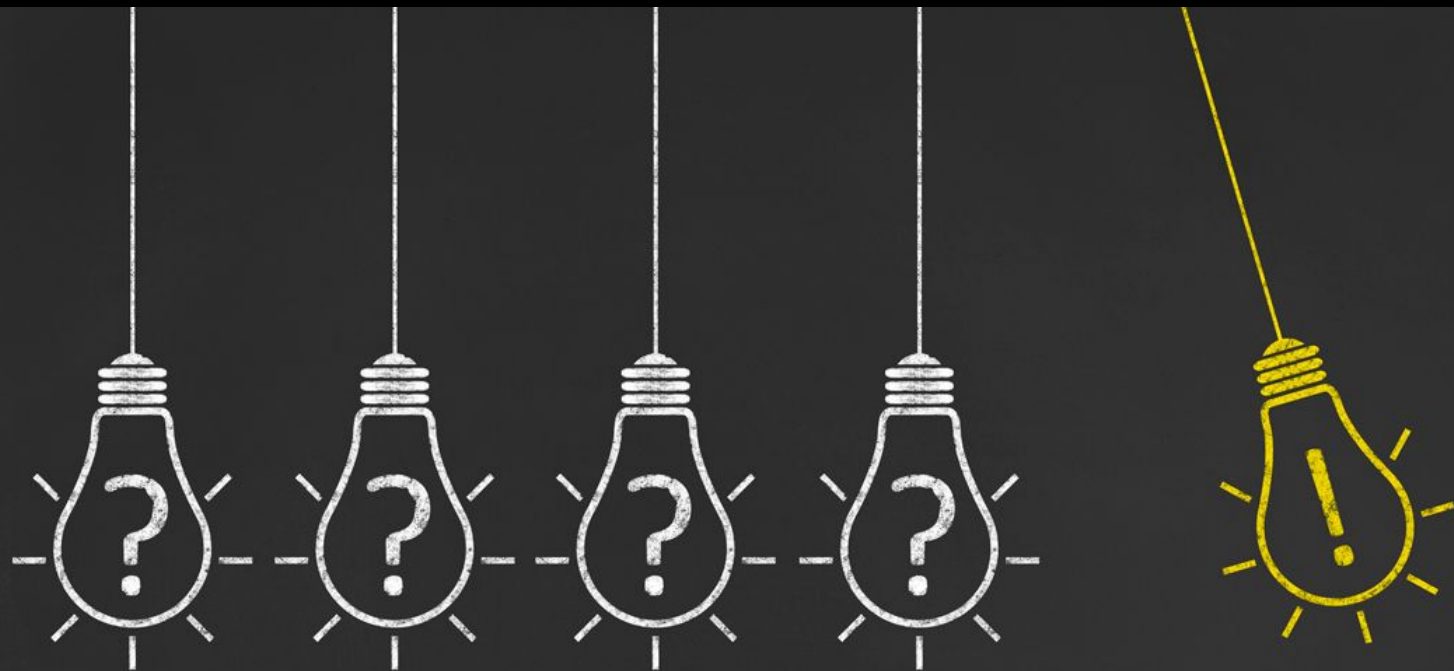

# A Sample Project

**Topic:** The Life of a Captive Elephant: Physical and Mental Mistreatment in Zoos

## **Research Question and Hypothesis**

- What aspects of an elephant's habitat negatively affect its mental and physical health the most?
- Inadequate enclosures, unspecific regulations, and interactions with humans damage the mental and physical health of elephants in zoos.



## Secondary Research Major Assignments

- ❖ Wrote 24 papers summarizing & evaluating scholarly sources
- ❖ Wrote a research proposal indicating research design, data collection method, etc.
- ❖ Located and contacted experts in the field
- ❖ Presented to authentic audiences
- ❖ Wrote a research paper.

# Primary Research Major Assignments

- ❖ Conducted interviews of experts in the field
  - Reporter from *National Geographic*
  - Director of Veterinary Programs and Research for Elephant Care International, and more
- ❖ Summarized Interviews
- ❖ Analyzed and presented collected data
- ❖ Created an e-portfolio
